NURSE PRACTITIONER'S PILOT PROJECT AT COMOX VALLEY SENIORS VILLAGE!

Comox Valley Seniors Village was one of two sites chosen for Island Health's Nurse Practitioner Pilot Project. This project aims to incorporate Nurse Practitioners as Most Responsible Practitioners in Long-Term Care, especially in communities that are experiencing physician shortages.

In addition to supporting residents with no family physician, Melissa and the CVSV team also plan to collaborate for quality improvement projects, education, and support for complex cases. Melissa is on site once a week to see residents and interact with the entire multidisciplinary team.

The CVSV team had some questions for Melissa:

What are your clinical areas of interest?

"Geriatrics, of course! And all that it entails, including medication de-prescribing,
